AFG does not collect personal non-public information through this Website; however, the Advisor may collect information from you on application forms, agreements, profile or investment policy statements, and other documents received or processed in relation to services we provide. We also may collect information from other sources.

We do not respond to "do not track" requests because we do not track you over time or across third party Websites to provide targeted advertising. We may track you across our Website to help us improve our content.

We may use "cookies" and similar online technologies to keep, and sometimes track, information about you regarding your usage of our Website. Cookies are small data files that are sent to your browser or related software from a Web server and stored on your device.
